She has published widely on Cold War history, the history of cultural globalization, human rights, and gender in foreign relations history. She is currently completing a book manuscript, *International History: A Cultural Approach*, in collaboration with Akira Iriye, to be published in 2022.

The global pandemic laid bare the tensions between globalization and nationalism in many parts of the world.

In the United States anti-globalization fervor had been stoked by President Trump even before the outbreak of the pandemic, as he engaged in economic protectionism and vowed to build a wall to keep unwanted immigrants out. Once the pandemic reached the United States, nationalist rhetoric and policies intensified. Yet the closing of borders, the protectionist policies, and the effort to blame other nations, especially China, for bringing the virus into the country, contrasted sharply with the knowledge that global scientific and political cooperation was vital for combatting the virus.

This lecture will discuss the ways in which the pandemic has made Americans see globalization as both as a curse and a cure in the current crisis.
