This series of 14 microfiches gives an hour by hour overview of the daily business of President Franklin D. Roosevelt. It lists individuals and groups he met at the White House and travel arrangements, including: press conferences; Cabinet meetings; members of Congress; foreign dignitaries; itineraries for trips, including train schedules and members of travelling parties such as journalists; official, semi-official and some social dinners; official telephone conversations; and bill signings. The collection runs from January 1933 until 15 April 1945, covering FDR's four terms in the White House.
