

Henry Morgenthau, Jr.: Press Conferences

Introduction

Over the course of his 13 years serving under Franklin D. Roosevelt, briefly as Governor of the Federal Farm Board and then as Secretary of the Treasury, Henry Morgenthau, Jr. held numerous press conferences. In these conversations with journalists, Morgenthau discussed dozens of topics, ranging from tax law to the prosecution of the war effort, from his personal relations with other members of the government to plans for the post-war order. Hence, these microfilm reels provide considerable insight, not only into Morgenthau and his career, but into the Roosevelt administration as a whole, both in terms of its domestic and its international policies and priorities.
