INTRODUCTION

The selections for this publication are drawn from two series of NARS Record Group 165: primarily from file series 10110 and, to a lesser extent, from file series 10058. Taken together, these two file series contain the most significant reports on American radicals between 1917 and 1941 in the records of the Military Intelligence Division.

U.S. Military Intelligence Reports: Surveillance of Radicals in the United States, 1917-1941 includes the major files within each of these series. However, minor files within each series as well as other less important file series have not been filmed for this publication. The researcher interested in this excluded material can pursue these files by referring to the name and subject indexes at the National Archives.

Also, it was not feasible or desirable in some cases to film the entire contents of those files selected for publication. Such omissions frequently include such printed matter as copies of radical magazines, handbills, pamphlets, and similar materials. Newspaper clippings were usually omitted as well. In other cases, duplicates, unimportant correspondence, and hopelessly corrupted documents were excluded.

There are, in addition, more substantive omissions. From series 10058, predominantly concerned with international communism, only materials related to American radicalism were selected. The lengthy lists of names of suspected subversives which M.I.D. compiled in later reports have been omitted for reasons both of space and confidentiality. Furthermore, most of the files concerned with radicalism and suspected subversion among American Negroes have not been included because they will be part of a separate UPA publication on domestic surveillance of black radicals.

Whenever such selections were made, the file entry in the user's guide is followed by the symbol (S). The file numbers in the user's guide can be used to obtain the complete original files from the National Archives.

Moreover, it was not feasible to microfilm negative photostats for inclusion in this publication. If, therefore, negative photostats hold

substantial research interest, the researcher should consult the original files at the National Archives. Deletions of such photostats are marked in the user's guide with a symbol indicating the number of pages omitted: (-2N), (-25N), etc.

UPA has remained faithful to the numerical order of the original M.I.D. files—even though this provides only the roughest chronological order to the collection as a whole. Reels 1 through 20 cover the years 1917–1921, the period of World War I and the "Red Scare." Reels 20 and 21 cover the rest of the 1920s; reels 21 through 32 span the years 1930–1941; and reels 33 and 34 (composing series 10058) return to World War I and the early 1920s. Apart from this rough chronology, file dates and subjects in the original system vary greatly with little apparent logic. Note that within any individual file the chronological arrangement is typically in reverse order (the latest material presented first).

The researcher should also note that this collection contains three distinct subsets of reports. The first subset, on reels 16 through 18, is the weekly "General Intelligence Bulletin" of the Justice Department's Bureau of Investigation. Included here is a nearly complete set of the "Bulletin" for the years 1920 and 1921, in its regular weekly installments and with occasional supplements. The next report subset, beginning on reel 19, includes files from army recruiting stations nationwide on local radical conditions in 1920. The final subset, on reels 24 through 32, contains regular monthly reports on radical activities from nine regional army corps areas throughout the United States from 1932 through the summer of 1941. Again, lists of individual names and many printed enclosures have been excluded. And as indicated in the user's guide, there are segments of the monthly corps area reports missing in the original files.

For a general history of the Military Intelligence Division from 1917 to 1941, including a description of the structure and operation of the "negative" domestic intelligence branch, the researcher may wish to consult Col. B.W. Bidwell's *History of the Military Intelligence Division, Department of Army General Staff* (Parts II and III), in National Archives Record Group 319 (call no. 2-3.7 AA.N at the National Archives).
