Justin Hart, who serves as the Roosevelt Distinguished Visiting Professor at the RIAS for fall 2017, holds the titles of Associate Chair and Associate Professor of History at Texas Tech University (USA), where he is also Senior Fellow with the Institute for Peace and Conflict.

He is the author of *Empire of Ideas* (Oxford University Press, 2013) and several articles and book chapters on U.S. public diplomacy and the cultural dimensions of U.S. foreign relations. He completed his Ph.D. in History at Rutgers University (USA).

His current project is a history of the failed campaign for Universal Military Training in the United States.

Justin Hart looks backward and forward to offer a comment on the status of the Rooseveltian Century nearly a year into Donald J. Trump's presidency in the United States. Are the much-lamented cracks in the trans-Atlantic alliance significant or superficial, temporary or permanent? Is it even possible, at this point, to identify a clear foreign policy agenda or vision from the Trump administration, given the conflicting messages that come from the president's advisers, as well as the president himself? The lecture will begin with remarks on the origins of the Rooseveltian Century and culminate in an assessment of its fate, now and into the future.
