"We are not recruiting colored Wacs at present," she said, "but if any of them wish to reenter the corps they can, but they will not be sent overseas because the theater commanders have not requested any."

fice of Colonel Westray Battl Boyce, Wac director, who stated that she handled public relations for the Wac colonel, volunteered to explain that colored Wacs were excluded from overseas assignment because there were no housing facilities available for them

The War Department announced last Thursday that 2,000 Wacs will be shipped overseas during the next four months for duty in the European and Pacific the aters and with the Caribbean Defense Command.

The majority of the personnel needed overseas will be selected from white volunteers now serv ing the Women's Army Corps, but a small portion will come from reentries who are being recruited to meet requirements. Skills needed primarily include administrative clerical, secretar-ial, communications, and a lim-

ited number of medical personnel. The initial shipment of 800 is scheduled for Germany during the first week of August. Wacs sent to the Pacific will, be as-signed to General MacArthur's headquarters in Tokyo and
